Recycling for Newaygo County (RNC) is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit whose mission is to provide convenient, affordable recycling in and around Newaygo County, and to teach the public about the importance of recycling. Our main pursuits include educating the public, supporting/maintaining single stream collection sites, and business endeavors.

Curbside recycling service is not feasible in most rural areas within the RNC service area. Our solution is single stream collection via drop sites in Newaygo, Fremont, Grant, White Cloud, Croton Township, Garfield Township, Hesperia, and Holton. Funding dollars come from Members, Friends of Recycling, Municipal contributions, and the Fremont Area Community Foundation. We strive to bring in the remaining funding required through Fundraising and Business endeavors.

No need to be blue ☹ if our pickup service is not an option for your company. You can still **GO GREEN!** by bringing your paper and cardboard to The Recycling Center, 490 Quarterline in Newaygo.

For **Free Cardboard Disposal**, look for the string of wire baskets in front of The Recycling Center and adjacent the Brooks Township Collection site off Division at 490 Quarterline Street, Newaygo. Come anytime.

For **Free Paper Disposal**, bring it inside via the Public Entrance on the north side (Quarterline) during public hours: Tuesdays and Thursdays Noon to 5 pm, Wednesdays Noon to 7 pm. Please keep office paper and newsprint separate if possible. If not, consider it all newsprint. ☺
